**ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE GENERAL LEGAL COUNCIL
SUSPENSION OF LAWYER KOJO GRAHAM FROM LEGAL
PRACTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **LAWYER KOJO GRAHAM** has been suspended from legal practice for a period of five (5) years commencing from **5th February 2026**.

The above-named lawyer was charged with one count under Rule 9 (10) of the Legal Profession (Professional Conduct and Etiquette) Rules, 1969 (L.I. 613) as follows:

Count 1

That he, as a lawyer purportedly acting for and on behalf of East Dadekotopon Development Trust collected a cash amount of USD 105,000 in his personal capacity from the complainant, Mr. Ziyad Yamak and issued receipt for same for the purchase of three plots of land from East Dadekotopon Development Trust, which he did not procure for the complainant's development.

Lawyer Kojo Graham pleaded not guilty to the said count. The Disciplinary Panel that tried him decided that the charge levelled against him had been made out. After his conviction on 24th July 2025, the Committee gave lawyer Kojo Graham the opportunity to refund the sum of USD 105,000 to the complainant prior to sentencing. He failed to comply with the directive and instituted legal action against the General Legal Council. Based on the recommendations of the panel

that tried him, the Committee decided to impose a five-year ban on his legal practice at its meeting held on 5th February 2026.

During the period of suspension, Lawyer Kojo Graham shall not hold himself out as a lawyer or attend chambers or render or purport to render any professional legal services to the public. He shall not attend chambers at any time during the period of his suspension.

The licence of **LAWYER KOJO GRAHAM** to practice for the next five (5) years is hereby withdrawn forthwith.
